Jackie Robinson statue PATH Plaza

A statue that faces Kennedy Boulevard commemorates Jackie Robinson's groundbreaking first major league game at nearby Roosevelt Field in Jersey City. With that game, played on April 18, 1946, he became the first black player in the modern era of organized professional baseball.


